St. Luke's – Christ's Body

While John Philip Beohm, Patriarch of the Reformed Church in America, was the founding pastor of St. Luke's Church, we can say that God, through Jesus Christ the head of the church, established St. Luke's congregation. With the shortage of pastors, the scarcity of population, and the isolation of farms there was little reason for a church in Trappe. Neither the people nor Beohm could resist the stirring in their souls, as God confronted them in their daily life. Thus the congregation began with the celebration of the sacrament and the experience of the real presence of Christ in their midst, on November 5, 1742.

St. Luke's is here because God wanted it here. All those in all generations, whose lives have been nurtured by the sacraments, know that the church is more than a gathering of people: In a very real nature, it is the Body of Christ in the midst of the world.

The hope for the 21st century is that the people may yield themselves to the indwelling Christ and, as that Body of Christ on earth, bring Christ to the community and the nation.

This is our heritage and this is our hope.

TUESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY


